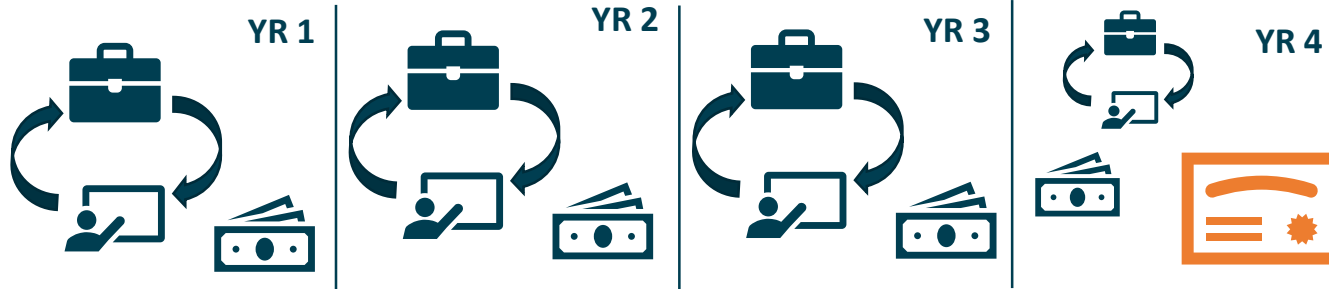


# REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP: Flexible Program Structure

## Traditional



Work Process and RTI occur concurrently in traditional apprenticeship programs. NOTE: Example shows a four-year program, however program length varies based on program occupation.

## Front Loaded



In front loaded apprenticeship programs, all (or most) classroom training occurs at the beginning of the apprenticeship program, followed by all of the work process hours.

## Segmented



This example shows a segmented apprenticeship program broken down into two segments where apprentices learn in the classroom, then continue their learning on the job.
